- Diploma will only be awarded if student has completed and passed both years.

The cost for this two-year diploma is as follows:

1st and 2nd Year:

OPTION 1 - payment plan

Deposit of R 4 200.00 payable on registration.
(Non refundable and no gift voucher may be used to make up for deposit amount)

AND

R 1 900.00 p/month (from end January until end of October equalling 10 months)

OPTION 2 - once of payment

R21 500.00 p/year – To be paid by 10th January of year of study

The fee *includes* the following - Pattern ruler and some text books

The fee *excludes* the following - Additional Text Books

- Stationary and basic needlework equipment
- All fabrics / materials used to make and complete assignment

*It is recommended that the student have his / her own sewing machine and overlocker.

Kindly contact our offices should you be interested to make an appointment for an interview. Please note that no specific subjects are required to apply, however, art and needlework would be an advantage during the course.

Please note we are awaiting our accreditation with the City & Guild in London, which will issue international diploma and registration with the City & Guild. Once accreditation has been approved annual fees will be increasing by R5000-00. This will be worked into payment plan.
